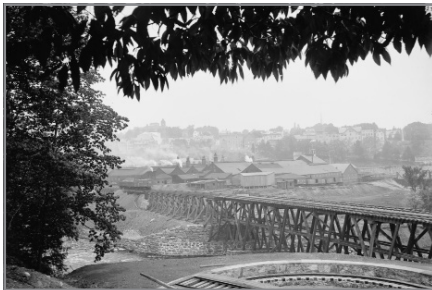


BOONTON IRONWORKS HISTORIC DISTRICT

BOONTON, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY



The Boonton Ironworks Historic District encompasses what remains from the prolific Boonton Ironworks and the Morris Canal, which were directly responsible for the development of the Town of Boonton beginning in the early-nineteenth century. Consisting of buildings, structures, above-ground and buried archaeological remains, and a park landscape, the Historic District encompasses approximately 55.5 acres and is largely contained within Grace Lord Park, a municipal public park.
