

# BUCCHLEUCH MANSION

NEW BRUNSWICK, MIDDLESEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY



Buccheuch Mansion, constructed circa 1735-1739, and located in New Brunswick, NJ is a well preserved colonial residence. Anthony White constructed the mansion for his wife Elizabeth, daughter of New Jersey royal Governor Lewis Morris. Today it serves as a museum, and the Jersey Blue Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution has been the building's caretaker since 1914.
