Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was built to serve the area of Morristown known as Little Dublin for its concentration of Irish immigrants, constructed in 1873 to replace an earlier church, the building was designed by architect Lawrence J. O'Connor in the gothic revival style. The Church of the Assumption remains a vital part of the Morristown community today, and also includes the 1890 rectory and 1872 ministry center building.
