The George A. Strong Residence, constructed in 1896 as a private residence was converted for use as a private school in 1933 and expanded with a gymnasium, classroom & auditorium in the mid 20th century. Today the former home serves as the duCret School of Art and remains a fine example of a Colonial Revival residential architecture reflecting the history of the suburban growth in Plainfield in the late 19th century.
