## HISTORIC PALACE THEATRE



NETCONG, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY



The Palace Theatre was constructed in 1919 with a traditional theatre façade inclusive of classical detailing and a low parapet wall. The theatre is an excellent example of the early- twentieth-century local theatre movement, and its façade has developed over time, reflecting changes in this movement. The theatre was purchased by its current owner, the Growing Stage Theatre for Young Audiences, in 1995.
