

LAFAYETTE SCHOOL

Roxbury Township, Morris County, New Jersey



The Lafayette School, constructed in 1921 to serve the Berkshire Valley section of Roxbury, is a cast-in-place concrete school building with rubblestone facing. The Lafayette School is significant as a surviving example of a two-room school (albeit modified), a once-prevalent building type in New Jersey constructed between the 1880s until World War I, but of which few examples remain today.
