Montville Museum is a historically and architecturally significant building located in the local Capstick Mill Historic District in Montville Township. Originally constructed as a schoolhouse in 1867, the building has served various purposes over time, including a meeting place for the Methodist Episcopal Church, a temperance hall, Town Hall, and the Montville Post Office. The building housed the Montville Museum since 1963.
