The Morris County Courthouse is a key resource in the architectural history of Morris County. The original 1827 building experienced numerous construction campaigns over approximately the next one hundred fifty years, resulting in the large complex that stands today just west of the historic Morristown Green. This architectural landmark forms an integral component of Morris County's history while remaining a highly-visible and well-used building in the present day.
