

Willow Grove Cemetery, which is owned by the City of New Brunswick, is the combined site of what originally were three separate and smaller historic cemeteries: the Presbyterian Cemetery, the Cheesman or Central Cemetery, and the Willow Grove Cemetery. The period of significance spans from 1837, when the Presbyterian Church first relocated some graves to the site, to circa 1922, when the three sites began to be viewed as one. The grave markers, fencing, and paths reflect this period.



- Services: Historic Preservation Plan including assessment of all grave markers and a landscape assessment.
- Recommendation included establishing better connections to the neighborhood, restoration and repair of grave markers, the planting of new trees and shrubs, and restoring the historic paths and fencing.
- Total Project Costs: \$51,750 (City of New Brunswick)
