

ATSION MANSION

Shamong Township, Burlington County, New Jersey



Atsion Mansion, constructed in 1826, is a rare and intriguing cultural resource that has survived from the early- nineteenth century with a large portion of its historic fabric left intact as it had been vacant since circa 1882. The building is architecturally and historically significant as it exemplifies Georgian style architecture and gives evidence to the once-thriving industrial town of Atsion. It was opened to the public for the first time in 2009.
